

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

This plat correctly represents INDIAN PARK NUMBER FOUR in part of VIRGINIA MILITARY SURVEY NUMBER 5245 in Bellefontaine, Lake Township, Logan County, Ohio. All distances are shown in feet. Angles shown on curved lines are central angles. Distances shown on curved lines are chord lengths. Points on the plat marked  $\bullet$  indicate the location of existing monuments. Points marked  $\circ$  indicate the location of iron pipe set on this survey. Survey made in May and June 1937. The area of the lots plotted in V.M.S. No. 5245 is 6.20 Acres. The area in the streets shown and not heretofore plotted is 1.06 acres. The bearings shown are true bearings.
