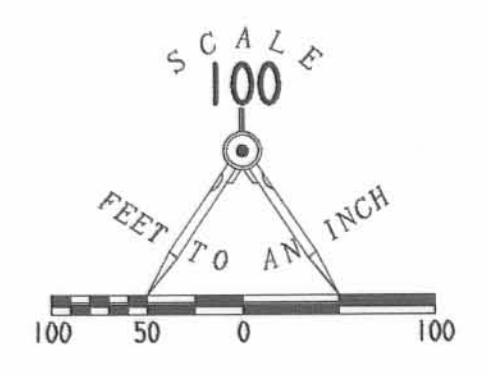

DESCRIPTION

Lying in Sections 26 and 32, Town 4, Range 14, City of Bellefontaine, Liberty Township, Logan County, Ohio. Being out of the Paul T. Humble and John J. Ziessler original 44.475 acre tract as deeded and described in Official Record 332, Page 700 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a railroad spike set on the north line of Section 32 at the intersection with the center-line of South Main Street and U.S. Route 68. THENCE with the center-line of South Main Street, S 4°-30'-00" E, a distance of 853.13 feet to a railroad spike set.

SURVEYOR'S STATEMENT

THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT REPRESENTS STREET DEDICATION FOR GUNNTOWN ROAD, SECTION 26 AND SECTION 32, TOWN 4, AND RANGE 14, CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE, LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO. THE STREET HAS AN AREA OF 3.472 ACRES OUT OF THE PAUL T. HUMBLE AND JOHN J. ZIESSLER 44.475 ACRE TRACT, OF WHICH 2.052 ACRE IS IN SECTION 32 AND 1.420 ACRE IS IN SECTION 26. ALL MEASUREMENTS ARE IN FEET AND DECIMALS OF A FOOT.
