DESCRIPTION

Indian Lake West Side Sub-Division Number 1 is a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 6 Range B, Stokes Township, Logan County, Ohio and is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the southerly Waterline of Blackhawk Channel with the Easterly Right-of-Way line of State Route 69; thence South 01° 57' West 222.0'; thence South 54° 30' East 548.5' to a point; thence on a curve to said Right-of-Way of State Route 69; a distance of 137'; thence North 85° 33' West 371.4' to the Route 365; thence South 85° 33' East 494.9' to a stake; thence North 40° 32' East 220.92'; thence North 52° 31' East 199.5'; thence North 54° 30' West 942.6' to the place of beginning and containing 5.57 Acres more or less.
