

# Surveyors Certificate.

The undersigned Surveyor do hereby certify that the annexed plat is a true and correct representation of John N. Leach's Addition to Quincy Logan County Ohio, as Surveyed, Platted and laid out by Me under the direction of the proprietor in August A.D. 1893. and that the same is a piece of land lying north of and outside of the corporate limits of Quincy Ohio and is bounded and described as follows To Wit: being the North part, of the North half, of the West half of the SW Quarter of Section No Twenty Three (23) Town Three (3) Range Thirteen (13) 1st M.R. Quincy. Commencing at a stone corner in the centre of Carlisle Street at the NW corner of said SW Quarter. Thence S 85° 27' East 814.9 feet to centre of Miami Street, and 25 feet to Centre of Jefferson Avenue intersection with east line of Miami St; Thence S 62° 45' East 533.9 feet to an iron pin corner. Thence S 4° 20' W 145 1/2 feet to a corner Thence West 288 1/2 feet to a corner thence N 4° 55' E. 914 feet. Thence N 62° 45' W about 232 feet or so where the south line of a 10 foot Alley crosses the south end of Miami Avenue as represented in the annexed plat. Thence N 85° 27' W to the right of way of the Ohio Southern Rail Road right of way line on the West side of track. Thence with said right of way S. easterly to the centre line of Carlisle Street. Thence N 85° 27' W 581.2 feet to centre line of Carlisle St. Thence N 4° 55' E. 509.0 feet to place of beginning containing 9.16 Acres. The entire line of Jefferson Avenue is the North line of the SW. Q. of Section 23 Leach Avenue is parallel to it. Carlisle Street angles South 89° 59' from Jefferson Avenue, and Logan Street is parallel to Carlisle Street. East end of Jefferson Avenue angles 67° 20' from Miami Street South, to Iron pin corner East. All lines of lots, streets, and alleys, have their lengths, and widths marked on them in feet and tenths of feet, as indicated by the annexed plat of the m. in testimony whereof I hereunto subscribe my name, on the 24th day of November 1893.

## Dedication of Streets and Alleys, to the Public.

John N. Leach, proprietor of the annexed plat, do hereby certify that the plat is as represented by Wilbur A.
