The Representatives of Nathaniel Burwell and John Beale enter 1000 acres of land on the following Military Warrants, Representatives of Burwell 722 acres on No 5348 and Beale 278 acres on part of No. 1384 on the waters of Big Miami; Beginning at the southeast corner of James Taylor and others entry No 9887; thence N. 78. E 400 poles, thence N 12 W and from the beginning N. 12 W. for quantity. Note - This entry like the previous one is situated on the line between Logan & Hardin Counties and a small portion is in Logan.

Thomas Custer enters 1000 acres of land on part of a Military warrant No 44 on the waters of Big Miami: Beginning at the southeast corner of the Representatives of Nathaniel Burwell and others entry No 9988; thence N. 78. E 400 poles, thence N 12 W. and from the beginning N. 12. W. for quantity. Note - A small portion of this entry is also supposed to be in Logan County. N.P.

Equal distance for quantity.

E 400 poles, thence and from the beginning S. 78. W. for quantity.
