



Surveyor's Office Bellefontaine O. Feb. 4th 1860.
 Surveyed this day for John M. Nelson and William Dubhain, three of the division lines between their farms, in C. V. M. survey No. 5245. Beginning at a stone at said Nelson's N. W. corner & in the East line of Wm. & John Kerr's land, from which an Ironwood bush bears N. 34° E. 8 links; & a Hickory bush South. 11 links distant; Run thence South 65° 47' E. 11.79 chains to a stone & part of a brick, from which a W. Oak 20 Inches dia. bears N. 56 3/4° E. 5 7/8 links; Thence N. 36° E. 1.57 1/2 chains to a stone & part of a brick; Thence S. 59° 47' E. 4.47 chains to a stone from which a small hickory bears N. 72° E. 5 links.
