

CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE SURVEY

Beginning for reference at a 1/2 inch square bar found in the north right-of-way of the C.C.C. and St. L. Railroad and in the south line of the Thermoid, Inc. 75.720 acre tract as described in O. R. Vol. 34 Page 562 (Tract One) said iron bar being in the west line of the northeast 1/4 of said Section 4;

Thence with the railroad right-of-way, on a curve to the left having a radius of 5679.65 feet, a central angle of $1^{\circ}-31^{\circ}-48^{\circ}$, an arc length of 151.66 feet, a chord bearing and distance of S.89°-24'-52"E. 151.66 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set at the southeast corner of said Thermoid 75.720 acre tract and the southwest corner of said Thermoid's 10.000 acre tract as described in O.
