DESCRIPTION
PROPOSED ANNEXATION
Job #8422

Being a parcel of land situated in Lake Township, Logan County, Ohio in the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 4 East, Range 14 North, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 34, T4E-R14N, this point being the intersection of the centerline of Township Road #216 with the centerline of County Road #11 said point marked by an existing railroad spike -

(1) Thence north $4^{\circ}-21'-04''$ east on the west line of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 and the centerline of County road #216 a distance of one thousand eighty five and $70/100$ (1085.70) feet to a railroad spike set on the intersection of the centerline of Township Road #216 with the centerline of Plum Valley Street -

(2) Thence north $67^{\circ}-21'-04''$ east on the centerline of Plum Valley Street a distance of three hundred eighty six and $59/100$ (386.59) feet to a P.K. nail set on the intersection of the centerline of Plum Valley Street with the existing corporation line of the City of Bellefontaine, Ohio -

(3) Thence south $86^{\circ}-23'-56''$ east along the existing corporation line of said city a distance of nine hundred eighty eight and $95/100$ (988.95) feet to the east line of Tract II as recorded in Volume 299, Page 151 of the Logan County Deed Records, being the 18 acre tract conveyed by Fred J. Molitor and Jo E. Molitor to Rose L. Darmstadter -

(4) Thence south $4^{\circ}-22'-20''$ west on the east line of Tract I and Tract II of the lands referred in (3) above a distance of one thousand two hundred sixty five and $98/100$ (1265.98) feet to a P.K. nail set on the centerline of County Road #11 and the south line of Section 34 -

(5) Thence north $86^{\circ}-0'-0''$ west on the centerline of County Road #11 and the south line of Section 34 a distance of one thousand three hundred thirty two and $88/100$ (1332.88) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 37.93 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.

Note - 1: All bearings refer to the centerline of County Road #11 and the south line of Section 34 as being north $86^{\circ}-0'-0''$ west.

Note - 2: The herein described parcel being part of Tract II and all of Tract I as recorded in Volume 299, Page 151 of the Logan County Deed Records, tracts conveyed by Fred J. Molitor and Jo E. Molitor to Rose L. Darmstadter.
