Being all of that 0.2 acre tract in the name of Marilyn S. Williams as deeded and described in Volume 378, Page 92 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron rod set at the intersection of the west right-of-way of Walker Street (30 feet wide) and the north right-of-way of Williams Avenue (34 feet wide).

THENCE, with the north right-of-way of Williams Avenue, N 86°-11'-00" W, a distance of 125.82 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the east line of the Mildrena Brown 0.20 acre tract (O.R. 24, Pg. 268), N 4°-11'-57" E, a distance of 66.45 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.


THENCE, with the south line of the Alfonso Breston 0.15 acre tract (Vol. 169, Pg. 350), S 86°-15'-25" E, a distance of 126.35 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the west line of Walker Street, S 4°-39'-14" W, a distance of 66.62 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 0.193 acre.

The basis for bearings is based upon the center-line of Williams Avenue being N 86°-11'-00" W and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey performed by Lee Surveying and Mapping Company on January 23, 1990.


