The following described real estate situated in the Village of DeGraff, Pleasant Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Fractional Section 7, Town 2, Range 14 of the Between the Miami Rivers Survey and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of Main Street (C.H. No. 24) and the centerline of Pleasant Street; thence with the centerline of said Pleasant Street S. 84°04' E. 264.4 feet to an iron bar; thence N. 5°56' E. 25.0 feet to an iron pipe in the north line of said street at the southeast corner of Charles M. Davis' 0.43 acre tract; said pipe being the beginning point of this description; thence with said Davis' east line N. 5°56' E. 300.0 feet to an iron bar, passing an iron pipe at said Davis' northeast corner at 150.0 feet; thence S. 84°04' E. 718.0 feet to an iron bar in the west line of the Greenwood Cemetery's 7.00 acre tract; thence with the west line of said 7.00 acre tract S. 5°22' W. 300.0 feet to a point in the north line of Pleasant Street, said point being N. 5°22' E. 25.0 from an iron bar in the center of said street; thence with the north line of said Pleasant Street N. 84°04' W. 721.0 feet to the place of beginning.
