

Hare Survey Harrison Township December 1964 1.56 Acres

The following described land in Harrison Township, Logan County, Ohio, and being in Section 5 Town 3 Range 14 M.R.S.

Beginning at a point in the centerline of U.S. Route Number 33 (Also known as the Bellefontaine - Huntsville Pike) where it intersects the north line of said Section 5. Thence southerly along the centerline of said U.S.Route Number 33 121.80 feet to a point for the true beginning point of this survey. Said beginning point being the S.W. corner of Gary Whaley's 1.24 acre tract.

Thence with the south side of said Whaley's 1.24 acre tract East 441.50 feet to an iron at the S.E. corner of said Whaley tract. The last described line being 120.00 feet south of and parellel with the North line of said Section 5.

Thence S. 8° - 23' E. 167.80 feet to an iron at the N.E. corner of a one acre tract in the name of W.N.Able.

Thence with the north line of said Able one acre tract N. 89° - 24' W. 375.50 feet to a point in the center of U.S.Route Number 33.

Thence with the center line of U.S.Route Number 33 N. 33° - 14' W. 59.60 feet to a point.

Thence again with the center line of U.S.Route Number 33 N. 26° - 13' W. 128.30 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described tract contains 1.56 acres.

The following described land in Harrison Township, Logan County, Ohio and being in Section 5 Town 3 Range 14.

Beginning at a point in the center of U.S. Route Number 33 at the S.W. corner of a one acre tract in the name of W.M. Able. Thence with the south side of said Able one acre tract S. $89^{\circ} - 24'$ E. 269.40 feet to an iron at the S.E. corner of said Able tract.

Thence with the east side of said Able one acre tract N. $0^{\circ} - 36'$ E. 151.70 feet to an iron at the N.E. corner of said Able tract.

Thence with the east side of a 1.56 acre tract in the name of Hare Homes Inc. N. $8^{\circ} - 23'$ W. 167.80 feet to an iron at the S.E. corner of a 1.24 acre tract in the name of Carey Whaley.

Thence with the east side of said Whaley tract North 120.00 feet to an iron in the south side of a 93.52 acre tract in the name of Arthur M. Frick.

Thence with the south side of said Frick tract which is also the north side of said section 5 east 994.00 feet to a point at the N.W. corner of a 20.87 acre tract in the name of Walter Dryja.

Thence with the west side of said Dryja tract S. $6^{\circ} 30'$ E. 930.60 feet to a point in the north line of a 20.06 acre tract in the name of Mildred Ashcraft.

Thence with the north line of said Ashcraft tract S. $73^{\circ} - 30'$ W. 521.00 feet to a point at the S.E. corner of 3.50 acre tract in the name of Robert Clagg.

Thence with the east side of said Clagg tract N. $32^{\circ} - 40'$ W. 436.40 feet to an iron at the S.E. corner of a 2.47 acre tract in the name of Robert Young.

Thence with the east side of said Young tract the following two courses and distances.

N. $23^{\circ} - 36'$ W. 191.00 feet.

N. $32^{\circ} - 40'$ W. 125.00 feet to an iron.

Thence with the north side of said Young tract S. $57^{\circ} - 20'$ W. 393.50 feet to a point in the center of U.S. Route Number 33.

Thence with the center of U.S. Route Number 33 N. $32^{\circ} - 40'$ W. 249.00 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described tract contains 20.03 acres.
