

ROPP 55 ACRE SURVEY

Lying in V.M.S. 4477, Jefferson Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being out of that original 176.45 acre tract lying in the name of Donald Ropp as deeded and described in Volume 394, Page992 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron rod found at an angle in the center-line of County Road 29 a distance westerly along the said center-line of 2742 feet from the centerline of County Road 55 and designated as being Station 58+25 in Field Book 602, Page 27 of the Logan County Engineer's survey of County Road 29.

THENCE, with the said center-line of County Road 29, N 59°-59' W, a distance of 253.58 feet to a railroad spike set for the southwest corner of this survey.

THENCE, N 29°-04' E, a distance of 1572.84 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set on the south line of a 40 acre tract (Volume 348, Page 341; Land Contract).

THENCE, with said south line, S 71°-25'-30" E, a distance of 698.34 feet to a 5/8" iron rod marking the southeast corner of a 2.53 acre tract (Mortgage Volume 349, Page 72).

THENCE, with the east line of said 2.53 acre tract, N 28°-49'-26" E, a distance of 544.07 feet to an iron rod found on the south line of an abandoned railroad.

THENCE, with the said south line on a curve having a central angle of 13°-34'-16" and a length of 727.02 feet. (The chord bearing being S 43°-00'-33" E, a distance of 725.89 feet) to the P.T. of said curve.

THENCE, S 36°-13'-25" E, a distance of 256.14 feet to a 5/8" iron rod found marking the northwest corner of the James Day 4.50 acre tract.

THENCE, with the west line of said 4.50 acre tract, S 13°-03'-30" W, a distance of 585.96 feet to a 5/8" iron rod at the southwest corner of said 4.50 acres.

THENCE, with the south line of said 4.50 acres, S 76°-56'-30" E, a distance of 557.94 feet to an iron rod found on the east line of V.M.S. 4477, being 15 feet westerly from the center-line of County Road 55.

THENCE, with the said V.M.S. line, parallel to and 15 feet westerly from said road center-line, S 5° -08'-30" W, a distance of 294.85 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set on the southeast corner of grantor's land.

THENCE, with grantor's south line, N 76°-52' W, a distance of 804.77 feet to a 5/8" iron rod.

THENCE, with the north line of a 17.661 acre tract, N 83°-54'-50" W, a distance of 1454.83 feet to a 5/8" iron rod found at the northwest corner of said 17.661 acre tract.

THENCE, with the west line of said 17.661 acres, 5 29°-04' W, a distance of 450.00 feet to a railroad spike found on the center-line of County Road 29.

THENCE, with said center-line, N 60°-56' W, a distance of 58.40 feet to the point of beginning.
