The following described real estate situated in Jefferson Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Virginia Military Survey 3137 and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin in the center of County Highway No. 5 at Sta. 361+90 as shown on page 39 of the Logan County Engineers Field Book No. 643, said iron pin being 35.0 feet North of the South line of said V. M. S. 3137; thence with the center line of said C. H. 5 N. $24^{\circ}-15'$ E. 194.1 feet to an iron pipe, said pipe being the beginning point of this description; thence N. $46^{\circ}-37'$ W. 259.8 feet to a post in the West line of the, now abandoned, T. & O. C. R. R. right-of-way as shown on the Logan County Engineers plan H-2; thence with said right-of-way line Northeasterly 484.5 feet to a post; thence S. $63^{\circ}-53'$ E. 67.9 feet to an iron pin in the center of said C. H. 5; thence with the center line of said C. H. 5 S. $24^{\circ}-15'$ W. 533.7 feet to the place of beginning.
