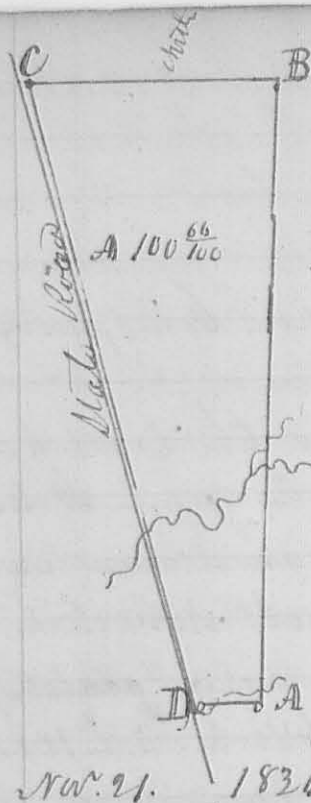

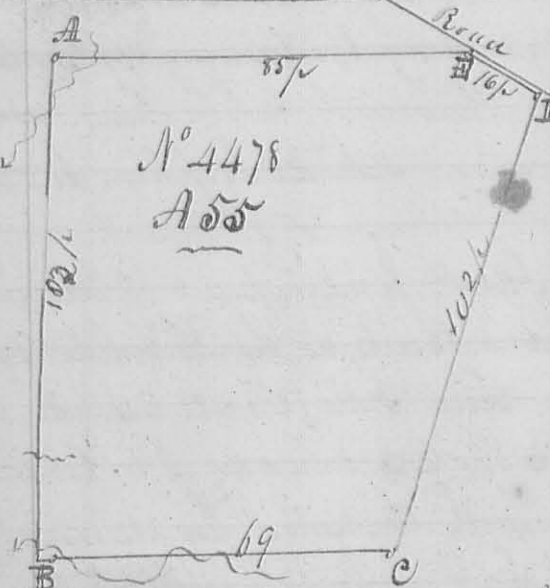

Surveyed Nov. 26. 1836 for Isaac Savage part of Military Survey N<sup>o</sup> 4478 as follows. Beginning at a Sugar and Elm N. E. corner near to Joseph Marquis and come to Sape Millner (See letter C) thence C D N 19° 6' 102 pole to Mark in the parcelled road, and in the South line of George Knutke's, thence with his line N 71° 18' 16 pole to a hickory, comes between said Knutke's & Isaac Savage, thence with 88 pole, crossing a stem, comes between said Knutke's & Isaac Savage, at 39 pole, crossing Isaac's branch at 74 pole to a stem near a small Hickory, thence South 103 pole, crossing a branch at 16 pole, and at 102 pole to a stem in Joseph Marquis' North line, thence 88 1/2 pole, crossing a small branch seen at times to the beginning, containing 55 acres.  to a Stone Cherry & Sassafras in John Marquis West line and  
 S. E. corner to said Humphreys. thence S 2 E 53 poles to a Cutting
