Thence with said centerline N. 6° 30' E. 150.00 feet to the place of beginning.



THOMAS TO ROMERO-COLE SURVEY

The following described real estate situated in the Township of Lake, County of Logan, State of Ohio and being a part of Fractional Section No. 31, Town 3, Range 15, B.M.R.S. and being a part of Forest and Ruth E. Thomas's present tract as described in Deed Volume 278 Pages 43-44 (11-1-1961) and being a part of Permanent Parcel No. 16-077-00-00-010 and being more prticularly described as follows:

Beginning at a Blue Granite Stone found at Station No. 92 + 41.4 of the centerline survey of T. R. No. 56 (North Troy Road) as recorded in Logan County Engineer's Field Book 561 Page 10, said stone being the southwest corner to Thomas's tract and the northwest corner to an 18.90 Acre tract in the name of Richard E. Groves et ux and also being in the west line of Section No. 31 and the line between Lake and Harrison Townships;

Thence with the centerline of T. R. No. 56 and the said west line of Section No. 31, N. 6° 30' E. 370.52 feet to a R. R. Spike set (note: this line is the Basis of Bearing for this survey);

Thence parallel to the south line of Thomas's tract, S. 84° 05' E. 1,107.99 feet to a 5/8" x 30" Rebar set in the Ludlow Line, which is Thomas's east line, passing through a 5/8" x 30" Rebar set at 30.00 feet;

Thence with the Ludlow Line, S. 13° 36' 09" E. 393.09 feet to a Stone found in the middle of a lane near the northeast corner to a cattlegard, said stone being the southeast corner to Thomas's tract and the northeast corner to Groves's tract;

Thence with the line between Thomas and Groves, N. 84° 05' W. 1,243.10 feet to the place of beginning, passing through a 5/8" x 30" rebar set at 1,213.10 feet, containing 435,544.125 square feet or 9.999 Acres. more or less.

Of the above described tract, there is 7,410.40 square feet or 0.170 Acres in the right of way of T. R. No. 56 which is 20.00 feet wide.

The above tract is subject to a 28 foot Permanent and Perpetual Easement as granted to Richard E. Groves et ux as recorded in Deed Volume 370 Page 153 (5-2-1977).


