

Thence North 0°17'34" West 405.75 feet, following the east line of said 5.637 acre tract, the west line of the remainder of said original 24 acre tract, and the west line of the remainder of said original 100 acre tract, passing at 386.40 feet an iron pin set, to a railroad spike found in the centerline of Township Road #185;

Of the above described 17.205 acre tract, 1.903 acres are within Virginia Military Survey 4478 (1.462 acres within said original 100 acre tract and 0.441 acre within said original 67.760 acre tract) and 15.302 acres are within Virginia Military Survey 4498 (all being within said original 24 acre tract).

Also, of the above described 17.205 acre tract, 0.336 acre is within the road right of way of Township Road #185.


