

Sharp Survey Liberty Township March 1961 4.48 Acres

The following described land in Liberty Township, Logan County, Ohio and being in Section 28 Town 5 Range 13

Beginning at an iron in the center of County Road Number 5 known as the West Liberty - Zanesfield - Rushsylvania Pike and being at the S.W. corner of Hanson D. Fortney's 56.00 acre tract and at the N.W. corner of the present 37.70 acre tract in the name of Charles Sharp and also being Station 29 plus 08 of said Road Number 5 as shown on Logan County Engineer's Road Plan X - 5 Page I

Thence with the south line of said Hanson D. Fortney's 56.00 acre tract S. 86 - 05 E. 396.0 feet to a square wood post.

Thence S. 3 - 00 W. 445.6 feet to an iron ✓

Thence N. 77 - 41 W. 138.8 feet to an iron. ✓

Thence S. 39 - 53 W. 46.0 feet to an iron.

Thence S. 61 - 26 W. 40.0 feet to an iron.

Thence N. 77 - 06 W. 289.2 feet to an iron in the center of said Road 5

A strip of ground 25.0 feet wide northward from and parallel to the last three described lines to be an easement for an outlet for road purposes for the Sharp farm of 33.22 acres.

Thence with the center line of said Road Number 5 N. 18 - 12 E. 341.0 feet to an iron at station 28 plus 00 of said Road Number 5 as shown on Logan County Engineer's Road Plans X - 5 Page I and being mid way between two concrete Road Markers,

Thence again with the center line of said Road Number 5 N. 2 - 24 E. 108.0 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described tract containing 4.48 acres and being out of the N.W. corner of the present 37.70 acre tract in the name of Charles Sharp.
