SURVEY FOR THE RALPH ROSE ESTATE 17.103 Acres October 16, 2001

Thence North 44°00'00" East (assumed bearing) 27.64 feet, following the centerline of County Road # 101, to a railroad spike found at the westerly terminus point of the constructed centerline of Township Road #109 (25 feet wide);

Thence North 44°00'00" East 21.77 feet, continuing with the centerline of County Road #101, to a magnetic nail set at the southwest corner of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract, said nail marking the intersection of the centerline of County Road #101 with the westerly extension of the north right of way line of Township Road #109, said nail also marking the place of beginning;

Thence North 44°00'00" East 1379.18 feet, following the centerline of County Road #101 and the northwest line of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract, passing at approximately 587 feet the east line of VMS 9931 and the west line of VMS 9932, to a magnetic nail set at the northeast corner of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract and at a northwest corner of Ralph B. Rose's 15.67 acre Tract II described in Official Record 383, page 951:

Thence South 46°57'17" East 1080.51 feet, following the northeast line of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract and the southwest line of said 15.67 acre tract, passing at 30.00 feet an iron pin set, to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found in the north right of way line of Township Road #109, said pipe marking the southeast corner of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract and the southwest corner of said 15.67 acre tract;

Thence South 81°42'46" West 1766.16 feet, following the north right of way line of Township Road #109 and the south line of the remainder of said original 17.60 acre tract, passing at approximately 1306 feet the west line of VMS 9932 and the east line of VMS 9931, to the place of beginning, containing 17.103 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 17.103 acre tract, 1.898 acres are within VMS 9931 and 15.205 acres are within VMS 9932. Also, of the above described 17.103 acre tract, 0.937 acre is within the right of way of County Road #101.




