

Freshner Survey McArthur Township 5.62 Acres May 1966

Beginning in the center of U.S. Route Number 33 which is the road from Bellefontaine to Huntsville, and in the center of the bridge over Cherokee Creek.

Thence with the center of said U.S. Route Number 33 S. 7° - 20' E. 296.75 feet.

NORTH
Thence N. 85° - 10' W. 829.70 feet to an iron in the east right of way of the C.O.C. & St.L. Rail Road. The last described line being the ~~west~~ side of a lane said lane being the north side of a 203.34 acre tract in the name of William B. McCormick.

WEST
East
Thence with the ~~west~~ right of way line of the C.O.C. & St.L Rail Road and following the present fence line N. 11° - 16' W. 305.00 feet to a point in the center of Cherokee Creek.

Thence with the center of Cherokee Creek S. 84° - 58' E. 850.70 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described tract contains 5.62 acres and is off of the south side of a 14.77 acre tract now in the name of Hazal Freshner.
