Surveyed and divided for John Harrod July 17.  
1835 - 272 acres of land off the north end of Survey No.  
9907 originally surveyed in the name of Thomas Warren.  
Beginning at the N.W. Corner of the Survey, at a Hickory  
Beech at the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Saw beams, the 3<sup>rd</sup> down, thence S 12 E  
108 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles to a Large Pigeon Oak, Buckeye & Sugar in the  
bend of a creek, thence curved at 10 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles, thence N 78 E  
400 poles crossing a road at 18 poles, one at 92 poles, reaching  
a Buck Cornier at 116 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles, a road at 126 poles, branch at 140  
a bend of the same at 190 poles a branch at 209 & one at 342 to  
2 Beeches in the ~~East~~ Northern of the Survey, thence N 12 W 108 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub>  
poles crossing a branch at 49 poles, and at 107 poles to two beeches  
N.E. Corner of the Survey, thence thence S 78 W 400 crossing  
branches to the beginning, at same time laid off 500 acres  
on the East end of the foregoing Survey by a line beginning  
at 2 Beeches S 78 W 73 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles, from the three Beeches mentioned  
above extending in the East line of the Survey, thence N 12 W  
108 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles to the three Beeches, two from oak root in the North  
line of the Survey & S 78 W 73 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles, from two Beeches at the N.E.  
Corner of the Survey

Surveyed at the same time part of Duncan all Section Survey  
N<sup>o</sup> (Number not known at the time of making the Survey) as  
follows. Beginning at the N.E. Corner, two Beeches thence S 12 E  
122 poles crossing a road at 16 poles, creek at 62 poles one at  
112, one at 20 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> poles, to Buck & Ironwood, thence S 78 W 202 poles  
crossing road at 20 poles, branch at 152 poles, to two Beeches  
thence N 12 W 242 poles, crossing branches to two beeches & Sugar  
thence N 78 E 202 poles, to beginning containing 303 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>100</sub>  
acres
