

Fitspatrick Survey Section 19 - 4-14 Monroe Twp. 1.69 Acres Feb. 1950

The following described land in Monroe Township, Logan County, Ohio and being in Section 19 Town 4 Range 14

Beginning at an iron in the center of County Road Number one ( Also known as the Ludlow Pike ) and the center of County Road Number 55 thence with the center of Road Number One N.  $20^{\circ} - 00'$  W. 559.6 feet to a small iron said small iron being the beginning point of this survey ~~thence/again/~~ and said point also being station I90 plus 50.6 of Ludlow Road survey as shown in Logan County Engineer's Book 598 Page 15 thence again with the center of Road Number one N.  $20^{\circ} - 00'$  W. 274.4 feet to an iron thence S.  $77^{\circ} - 54'$  W. 252.0 feet to an iron pipe the last described line passing an iron pipe at the west side of Road Number one at 30.29 feet ( said road being sixty feet wide when measured at right angles ) thence S.  $12^{\circ} - 06'$  E. 271.8 feet to an iron pipe thence N.  $77^{\circ} - 54'$  E. 289.70 feet to the place of beginning the last described line passing an iron pipe at the West side of Road Number one at 259.41 feet said tract containing 1.69 Acres.
