Thence North 68°17'12" East 341.92 feet, passing an iron pin set at 311.75 feet, to a magnetic nail set in the centerline of State Route 287, the east line of V.M.S. 3228, the west line of V.M.S. 9679, and the east line of said original 68.00 acre tract;

Thence South 15°39'00" East 607.40 feet, following the centerline of State Route 287, the east line of V.M.S. 3228, the west line of V.M.S. 9679, and the east line of said original 68.00 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 4.207 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above-described 4.207 acre tract of land, 0.417 acre is within the road right-of-way of State Route 287.




