Lying in V.M.S. 3221, Monroe Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being the west part of that 30.00 acre tract lying in the name of Lockwood as deeded and described in Volume _____, Page _____ of the Logan County Records of Deeds, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron rod found on the north line of said 30.00 acre tract, marking the southeast corner of a 15.00 acre tract (Volume 399, Page 226) and being N 74°-51'-40" E, a distance of 1327.01 feet from the center-line of County Road 28.

THENCE, S 14°-27'-20" E, a distance of 660.00 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set on the south line of said 30.00 acres.

THENCE, with the said south line, S 74°-51'-40" W, a distance of 503.83 feet to an iron rod found marking the southwest corner of said 30.00 acres.

THENCE, with the west line of said 30.00 acres, N 14°-27'-20" W, a distance of 660.00 feet to a 5/8" iron rod at the northwest corner of said 30.00 acres.

THENCE, with the north line of said 30.00 acres, N 74°-51'-40" E, a distance of 503.83 feet to the point of beginning.

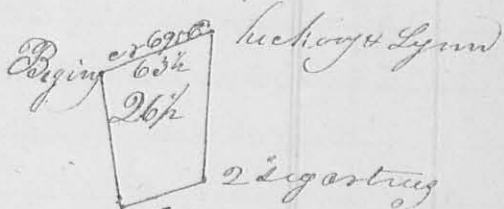

Surveyed 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres for Samuel Colyas: Beginning at a point in the road from Goshen to head of King's creek at the corner of the lands of William Pearson and Samuel Colyas, a lichen 15 inches in diam bears $N 15^{\circ} W$ 20 links distant; thence with the line between Colyas and Pearson $S 63^{\circ} E$ 67 poles to a small lichen and lynn in said line, comes to Jeremiah Cook's land; thence $S 5^{\circ} W$ 77 poles to 2 small sugar trees (one of which is dead) South west corner to Cook; thence $S 6^{\circ} W$ 5 poles to a stake in said road - thence with said road $N 88^{\circ} W$ 67 poles to beginning, being part of Holland Honap's survey no 3221

Surveyed 94 acres for Samuel Colyas Beginning at a stake in the road from Goshen to the head of King's creek and in the north line of the West land meeting house lot, thence with said line $N 87^{\circ} E$ 255 poles to the $N. E.$ corner thereof a stone thence $S 5^{\circ} E$ 38 poles to 2 small iron woods, thence $N 69^{\circ} E$ passing 2 buckies $N. W.$ corner to Baldwin's land at 78 poles 162 poles to a buck and sugar tree, south east corner to the original survey, thence with the east line thereof $N 24^{\circ} W$ 94 poles to a sugar tree and fallen red oak corner to Jer. Cook's land, thence with his south line $S 69^{\circ} W$ 170 poles (passing the south west corner of Cook's land at 118 poles) to a stake in the road from Goshen to the head of King's creek thence with said road $N 21^{\circ} E$ 26 poles to the beginning being part of H. Honap's survey no 3221
