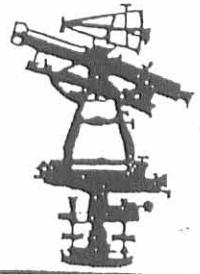

thence S-75°52'17"-W, 448.14' (feet) to an iron bar set at the Northwest corner of said McGuire's tract;

thence with the West line of said McGuire's 14.64 acre tract, S-14°36'09"-E, 776.73' (feet) to a 5/8" diameter iron bar with "Lee" cap found at the Northwest corner of a 126.44 acre tract also conveyed to Nicholas D. 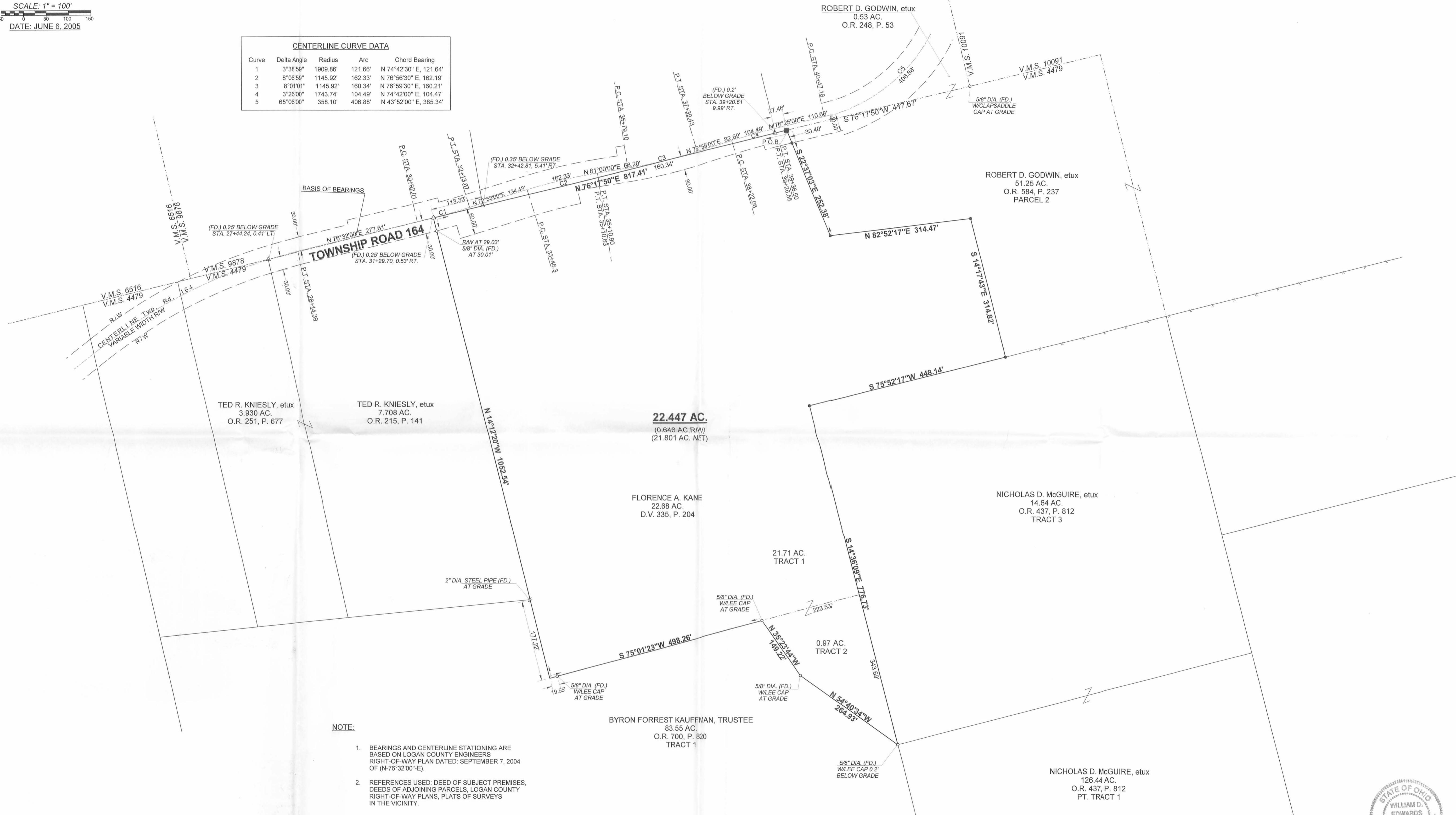
PLAT OF SURVEY

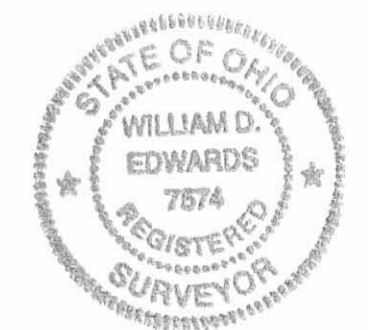

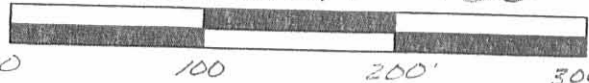

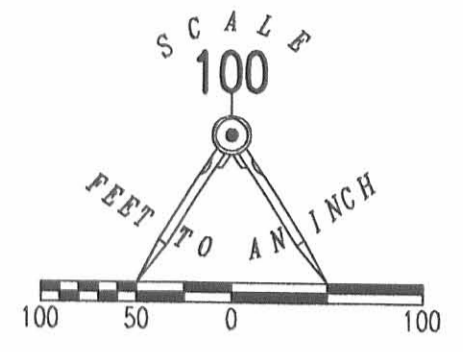
