

Harshbarger to Latimer Survey

January, 1973

Being situated in Pleasant Township, Logan County, Ohio; and being a part of Sections 8 and 9, Town 2, Range 14.

Beginning at a point in the center of County Road 24 that is known as Station 100 + 74 in the Logan County Engineer's Field Book 516, page 67. Said beginning point is also the northeast corner of a 53.30 acre tract.

Thence with the center of County Road 24 N 26° - 00'W 564.3 feet to a iron, passing thru the line between Section 8 and Section 9 at 201.5 feet.

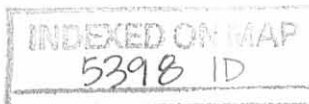
Thence S 10° - 48'W 497.7 feet to a iron.

Thence with the north line of said 53.30 acre tract S 86° - 55'E 341.2 feet to the place of beginning.

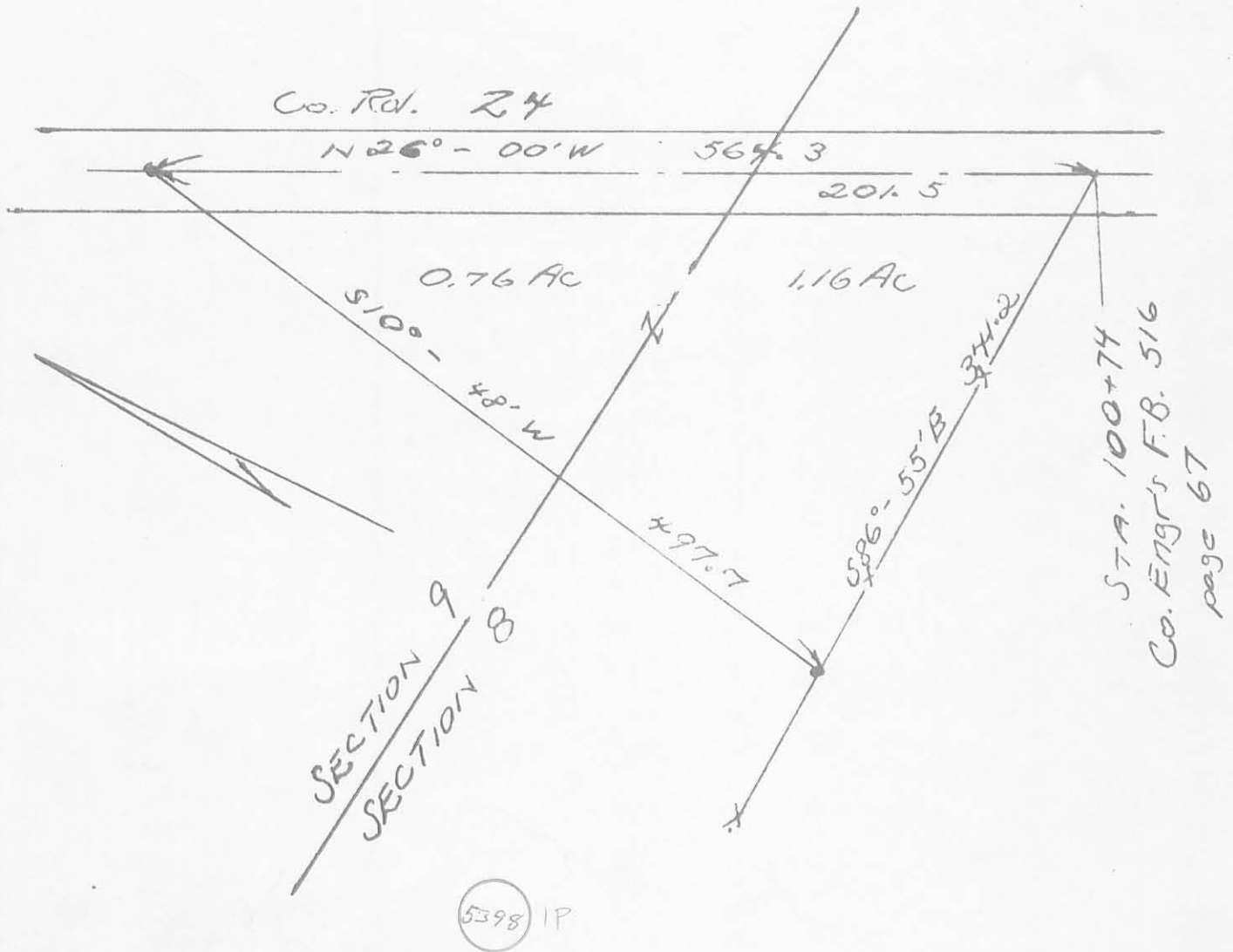
Containing 1.92 acres of which 1.16 acres is from a 7.00 acre tract in Section 8 and 0.76 acre is from a 7.20 acre tract in Section 9.
