

ORDINANCE NO. <u>02-2015</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AN ALLEY

WHEREAS, the Village of Quincy, Ohio, has legislative authority for care, supervision, and control of public roads, grounds, and bridges,

AND WHEREAS it has come to the attention of the village council of the Village of Quincy, Ohio, that there is an alley described in the attached Exhibit A for which there is good cause to vacate,

AND WHEREAS the Council has determined that the vacation of the described alley would not be detrimental to the general interests of the citizenry of Quincy, Ohio,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Exhibit A, which is a description of the alley in question, is hereby incorporated by reference into this document.
- 2. There is good cause to vacate the alley and the vacation of the alley would not be detrimental to the general interest of the Village of Quincy, and
- 3. The alley is, therefore, vacated by action of the Council of the Village of Quincy, Ohio.

Council has determined that the vacation of the alley should not pass as an emergency measure but rather should be passed on three readings.

At the regularly scheduled council meeting on December 16, 2014, it was moved, seconded, and passed on the first reading.

At the regularly scheduled council meeting on January 6, 2015, it was moved, seconded, and passed on the second reading.

No action was taken at the regularly scheduled meetings on January 20, 2015 or February 3, 2015.

At the regularly scheduled council meeting on February 17, 2015, it was moved, seconded, and passed by vote of Council on the third and final reading.

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Council of the Village of Quincy, Ohio, that the alley described in the attached Exhibit A is hereby vacated and the ownership of the alley hereafter shall revert to the neighboring owners in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.

Being situated in the County of Logan, the State of Ohio, the Township of Miami, and the Village of Quincy, and being further described as follows:

An alley 20 feet wide, more or less, and 130 feet long, more or less, and being between Lots 128, 129, and 130 of the Village of Quincy, Ohio, on the one side and Lot 135 on the other side. The alley further is between Canby Street on the west and Miami Street on the east and between New Street on the south and South Street on the north. Attached as Exhibit B and Exhibit C are maps showing the area to be vacated in yellow highlight and cross hatched. Said alley being part of Blackley's Addition (Plat Cab. A, Slide 93)
