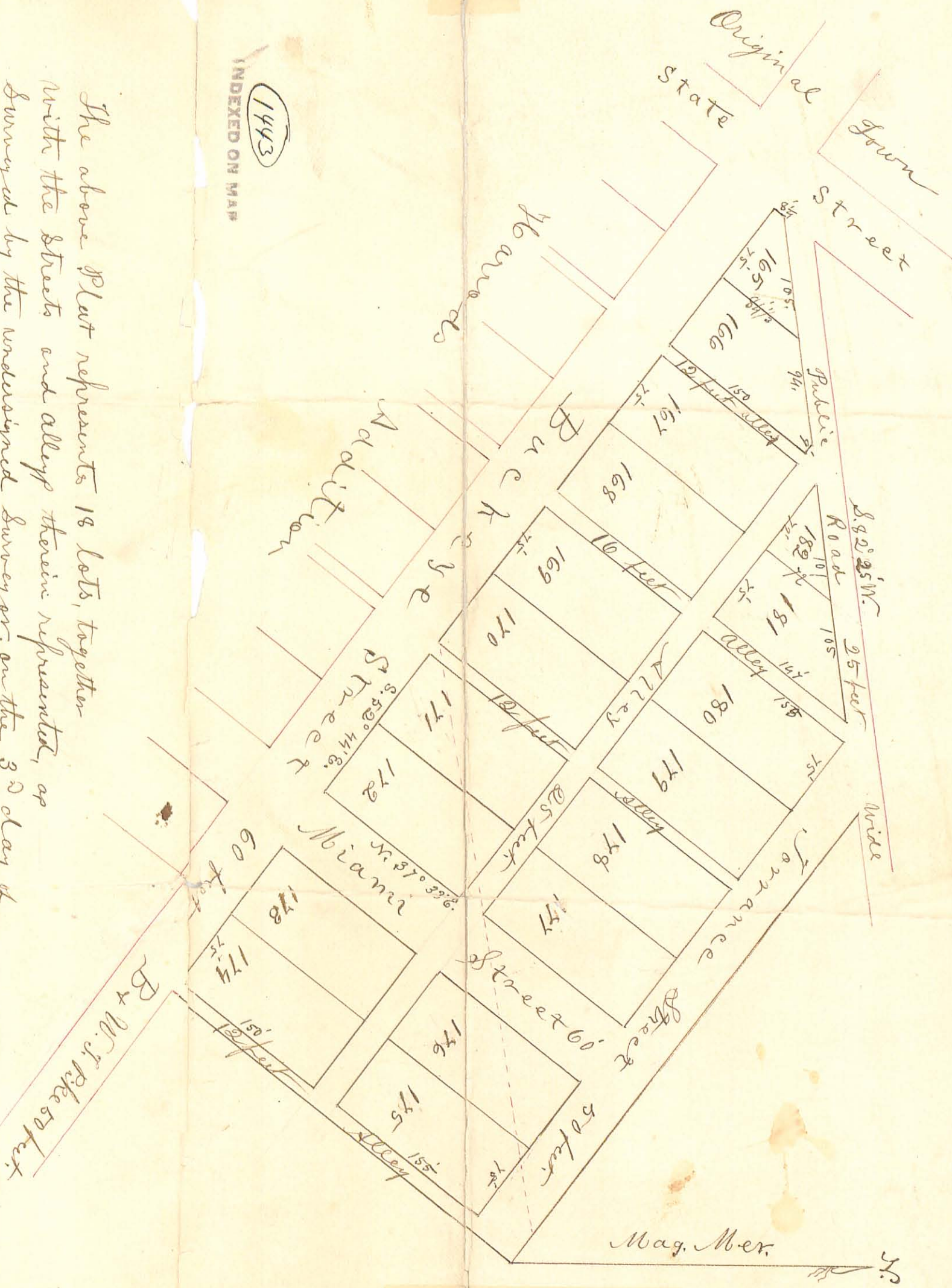


Plat of McBluer and Wegger's Addition to Bellecenter

The above Plat represents 18 lots, together with the streets and alleys therein represented, as surveyed by the undersigned surveyor, on the 3^d day of May 1883, at the instance and under the direction of Wm. A. Blair & McBluer and John Wegger (the proprietors of the premises) to be known as McBluer & Wegger's addition to the town of Bellecenter, and being a part of P. V. M. Survey No 9972, in the name of James Taylor et al, and situate in Richland Township in the county of Logan and State of Ohio, and containing 6.24 acres of land of which 4.32 acres belong to the said Wm. Blair & McBluer and 1.92 acres belong to the said John Wegger, the broken red line across the Plat being the line between said parties the later owning on the South, and the former on the north of said line. Five feet is hereby added to the north east side of Buckeye Street making it 60 feet wide as far as to the east side of Sparrow's addition and there being 55 ft to the east side of My addition. Three feet ~~and~~ Miami Street and the alley parallel therewith are extensions of those in Sparrow's addition, except the most easterly way. Johnson Street is 50 feet wide and in the same extended line of the same street in Sparrow's addition, the alley south of, and parallel with Buckeye Street is 25 feet wide. The 25 feet space north of the addition is now open to the public, and is used for many years. The lot facing on Buckeye Street are 75 feet wide and the full lots 150 feet long. The lots facing on Jarrance Street are 75 feet wide and 155 feet long. The size of the portions on market on the Plat, I hereby certify the above Plat, and the words and figures explanatory thereof to be a true and accurate representation of the things therein set forth. Witness my hand this 4th day of May 1883.

Know All Men by these Presents, that Annie E. McBluer an unmarried woman, and John Wegger and Caroline ~~Wegger~~ a single woman, Proprietors of the lands represented by the above Plat and record of Town Lots, and consideration of the benefit of the public to proprietors of additions to towns, have authorized the laying out and platting thereof, and do hereby give and grant to the respective villages of Bellecenter Logan County Ohio, the streets and alleys represented by said plat, the same for public highways forever, the said lots, streets and alleys to be known as McBluer & Wegger's addition to the town of Bellecenter. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day of A.D. 1883 one thousand eight hundred and eighty three.

McBluer, an unmarried woman, ~~and~~ John Wegger and Caroline Wegger the grantors in the foregoing conveyance and acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof to be their voluntary act and deed for the uses and purposes therein indicated, and the said Caroline Wegger, Wife of the said John Wegger, being at the same time examined by me separate and apart from her said husband, and the contents of said instrument made known and explained to her by me as the Statute direct, then declared that she did voluntarily sign seal and acknowledge the same, and that she is still satisfied therewith as her voluntary act and deed.
