

Temp - Willis Survey Rushcreek Township Oct. 1958 3.82 Acres

The following described land in Rushcreek Township, Logan County Ohio and being in V.L.S. 9932

Beginning in the center of State Highway Number 226 also known as U.S. Route Number 68 and in the center of State Highway Number 579 also known as State Route Number 274 thence with the center of said U.S. Route Number 68 N. 37 - 50 E. 1312.23 feet to a small iron for the beginning point of this survey and said beginning point being station 216 plus 59.80 as shown on Logan County Engineer's Record L - 18 page 6 thence again with the center line of U.S. Route Number 68 N. 37 - 50 E. 713.10 feet to a small iron thence S. 52 - 10 E. 190.70 feet to an iron the last described line passing an iron at the east side of the State Road at 35.00 feet thence S. 26 - 23 W. 598.50 feet to an iron at the east side of a square wood post thence N. 74 - 34 W. 334.80 feet to the place of beginning the last described line passing an iron at the east side of the State Highway at 297.00 feet (being 35.00 feet from the center line of the Highway when measured at right angles) said described tract containing 3.82 acres and being on the east side of said State Highway and being out of the west side of the present 111.88-acre tract.
