

HEMPY SURVEY

The following described real estate situated in Rushcreek Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Virginia Military Survey #3323 and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin at the intersection of the center lines of County Highway #5 and County Highway #122, as shown on page 52 of the Logan County Engineer's field book #666; thence with the center line of said County Highway #5 S. 25°-24' W. 362.5 feet to an iron pin in the North line of said V. M.S. 3323, said pin being the beginning point of this description; thence continuing with said center line S. 25°-24' W. 9.9 feet to an iron pin, Sta. 69+22.2 as shown on page 70 of the Logan County Engineer's field book #588; thence with said center line S. 13°-05' W. 467.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83°-40' W. 118.7 feet to a wood post; thence N. 6°-32' E. 437.1 feet to an iron pipe in the North line of said V. M. S. 3323; thence with said survey line N. 84°-28' E. 179.3 feet to the place of beginning.
