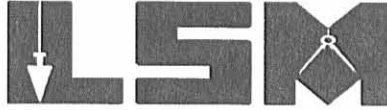

Lying in Virginia Military Survey 10041, Village of Rushsylvania and Rushcreek Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Being out of the Lynda Shipp Raid original 21.06 acre tract as deeded and described in Volume 376, Page 141 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stone found in a monument box at the southwest corner of Virginia Military Survey 10041 on the center-line of County Highway 5.

THENCE, with the south line of Virginia Military Survey 10041 and the center-line of County Highway 5 (60 feet wide), N 84°-30'-00"E, a distance of 888.56 feet to a MAG nail set at the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

THENCE, N 8°-10'-53"W, a distance of 600.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 30.03 feet.

THENCE, N 84°-30'-02"E, a distance of 199.95 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the west lines of the Thomas F. Daley original 18.82 acre tract (Vol. 384, Pg. 426) and the Thomas F. Daley 4.923 acre tract (O.R. 388, Pg. 255), S 8°-11'-10"E, a distance of 600.00 feet to a mine spike found, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 569.97 feet.

THENCE, with the south line of Virginia Military Survey 10041 and the center-line of County Highway 5, S 84°-30'-00"W, a distance of 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 2.751 acres, of which 0.138 acre is within the highway right-of-way. 2.258 acres are within the Village of Rushsylvania.

The basis for bearings is the south line of Virginia Military Survey 10041, being S 84°-30'-00"W, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Co., Inc. on July 27, 2004.

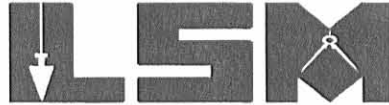

THENCE, N 8°-10'-53"W, a distance of 489.02 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the south line of the Gary E. Downey 53.908 acre tract (O.R. 191, Pg. 256, Tract I), N 84°-59'-31"E, a distance of 200.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found.

THENCE, with the west line of the Thomas F. Daley original 18.82 acre tract (Vol. 384, Pg. 426), S 8°-11'-10"E, a distance of 487.31 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, S 84°-30'-02"W, a distance of 199.95 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 2.238 acres, of which 1.075 acres are within the Village of Rushsylvania.

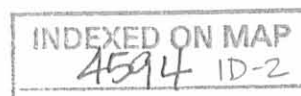

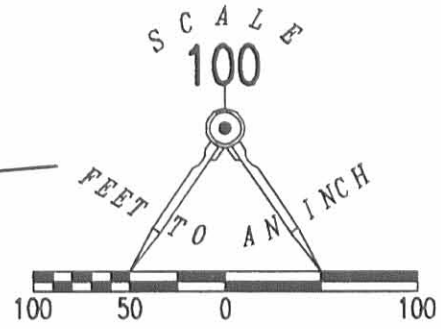

Thence with said Raid's east line N. 8° 11' 00" W. 310.34 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set, passing the east corporation line of the Village of Rushsylvania at 175.0 feet.

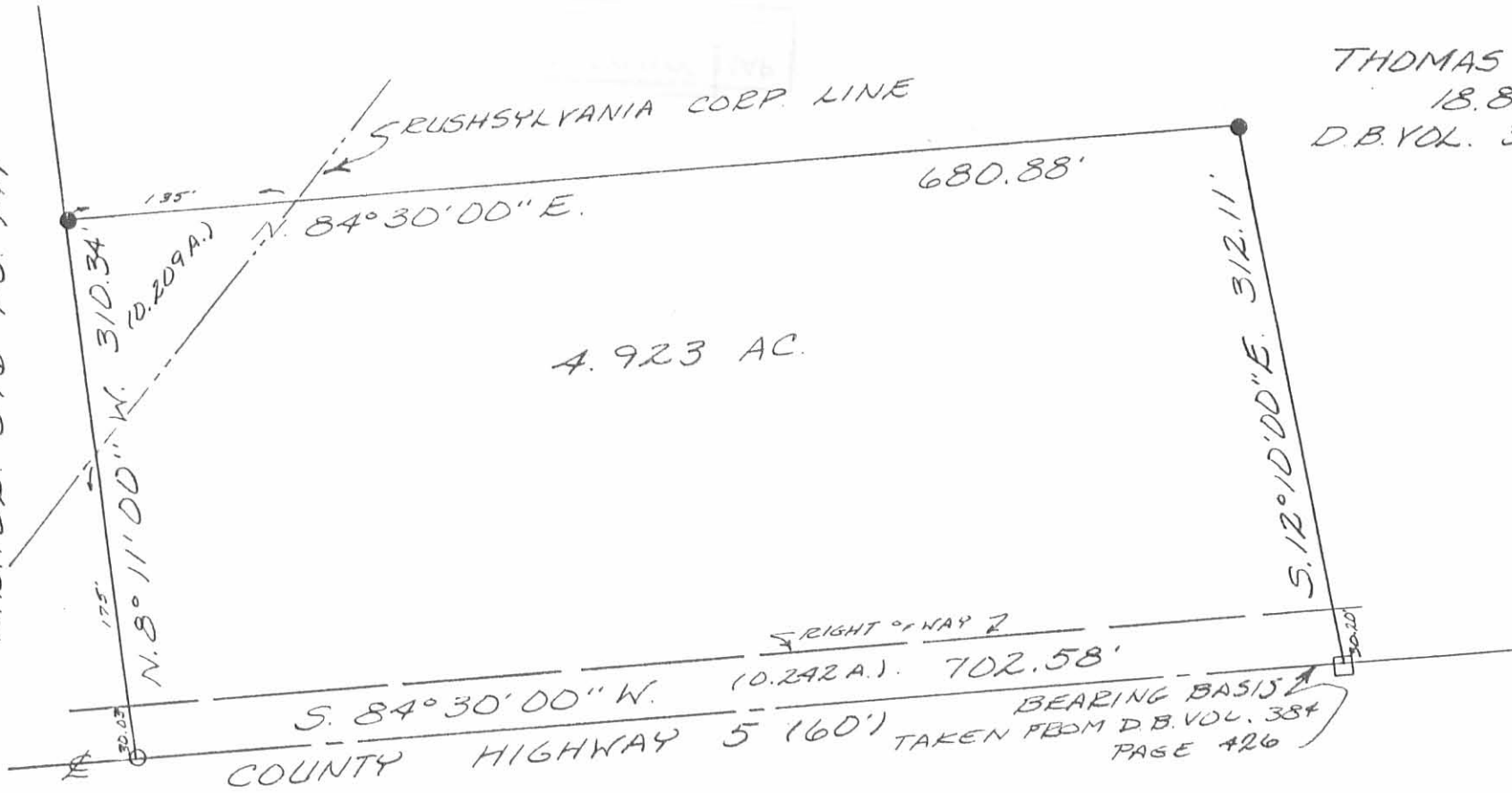
