V.M.S. LINE



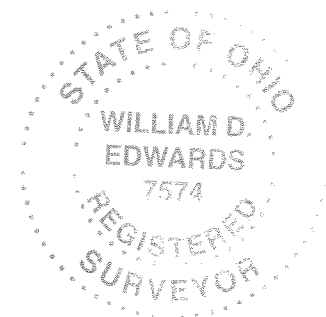

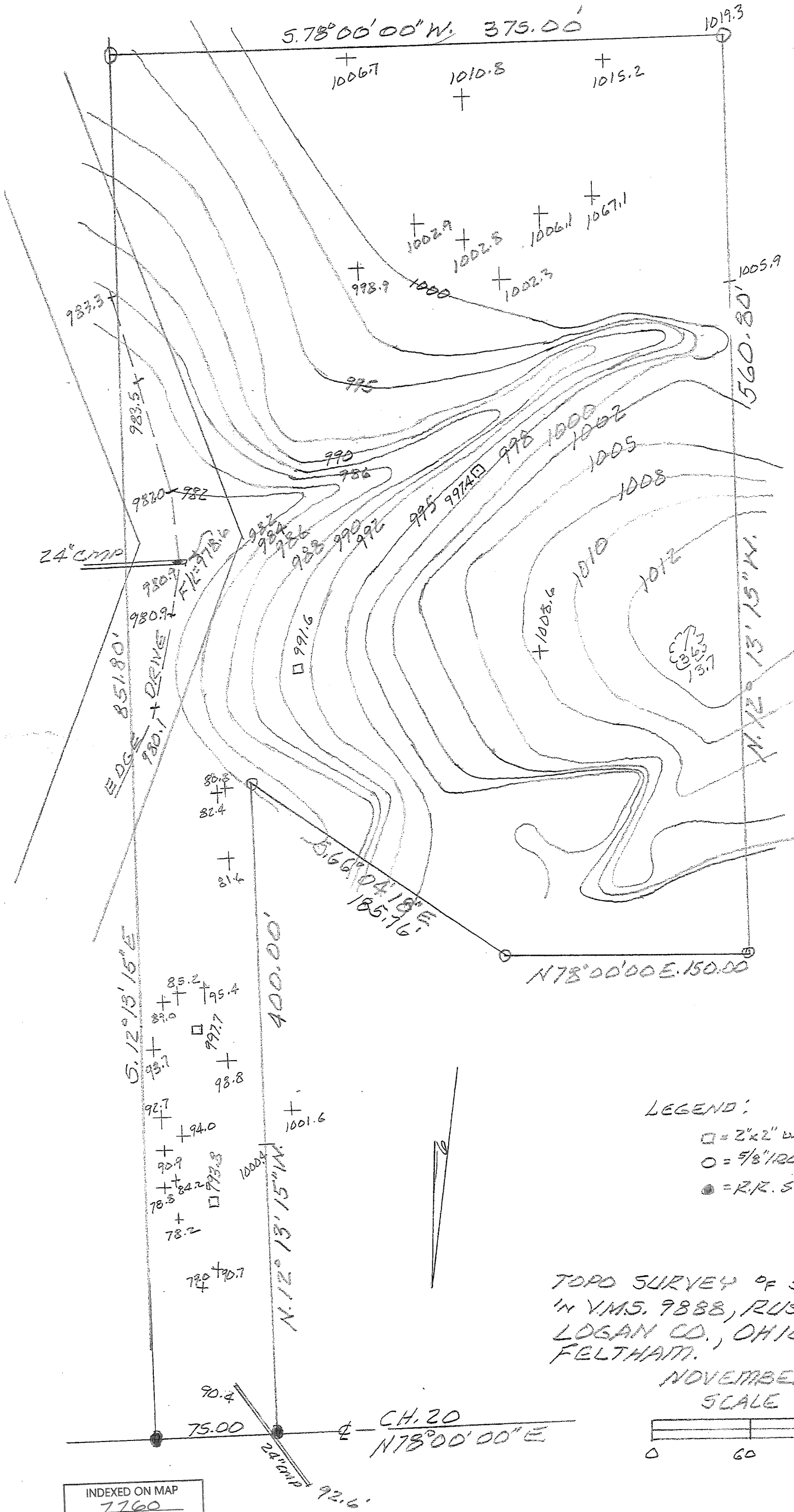

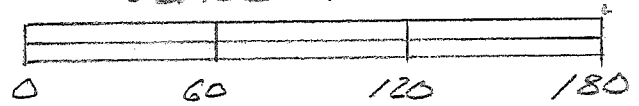
