AN ORDINANCE

Regulating the speed of automobiles, motorcycles and any and all motor-driven vehicles.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Rushsylvania, Logan county, Ohio, Section 1. That no person operating an automobile or any motor-driven vehicle shall operate the same at a speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having in regard to the use in common of such highway or place, or so as to endanger the life and limb of any person; and in no event shall any such automobile or motor-driven vehicle be operated at a greater rate of speed than eight miles per hour in any thoroughfare or highway within the corporate limits here or highway of Rushsylvania, Ohio.

Section 2. And the Street Committee is hereby authorized to erect or cause to be erected suitable signboards at the corporation line on all roads leading into and entering said village of Rushsylvania, Ohio, and each of said signboards to have the following inscription thereon in large black letters on a white background, to-wit: "Rushsylvania, Ohio, Corporation Line, Observe the Speed Limit." The expense of said signboards and the maintenance thereof shall be paid out of the street repair fund of said village.

Section 3. Whoever violates the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be fined the Mayor of said village be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars, and shall pay all the costs of the prosecution, and in default of the payment of said fine and costs shall be committed to prison until the same has been paid or is by law discharged.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
