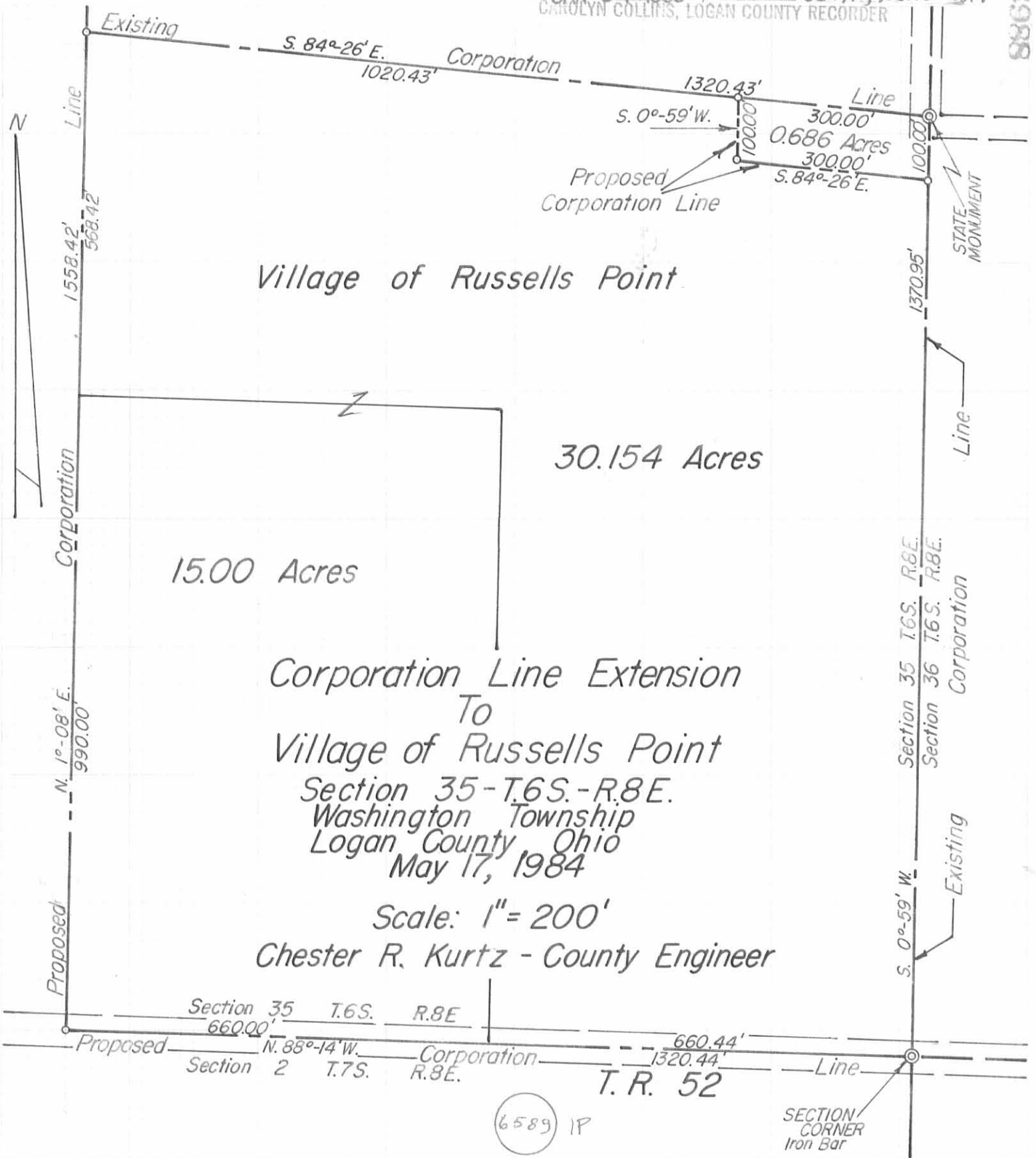

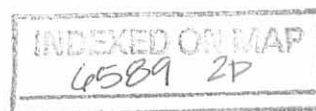

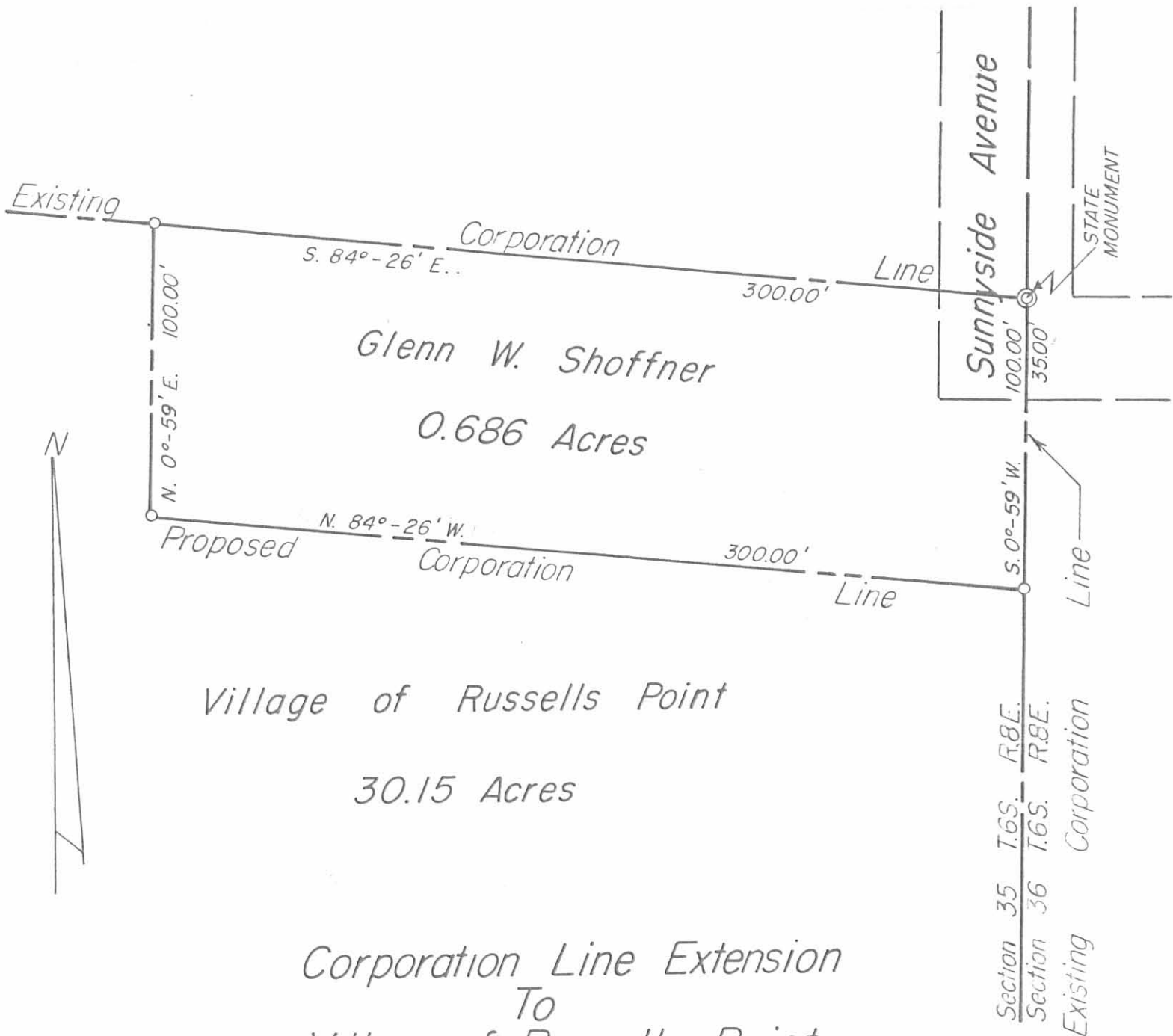

Beginning at the State Monument, which is also the northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter and being in the east line of said Section No.35 and also being a corner to the present Corporation Line to said Village; thence S.0°59'W. 100.00 feet with said Section Line and Corporation Line to a point, passing the south line of Sunnyside Avenue (formerly Center Street) at 35.00 feet; thence N.84°26'W. 300.00 feet to a point; thence N.0°59'E. 100.00 feet to a point in the north line of said Quarter Section and also being the present Corporation Line; thence with said Quarter Section Line and Corporation Line, S.84°26'E. 300.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.686 acres, more or less.

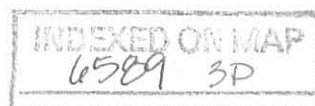

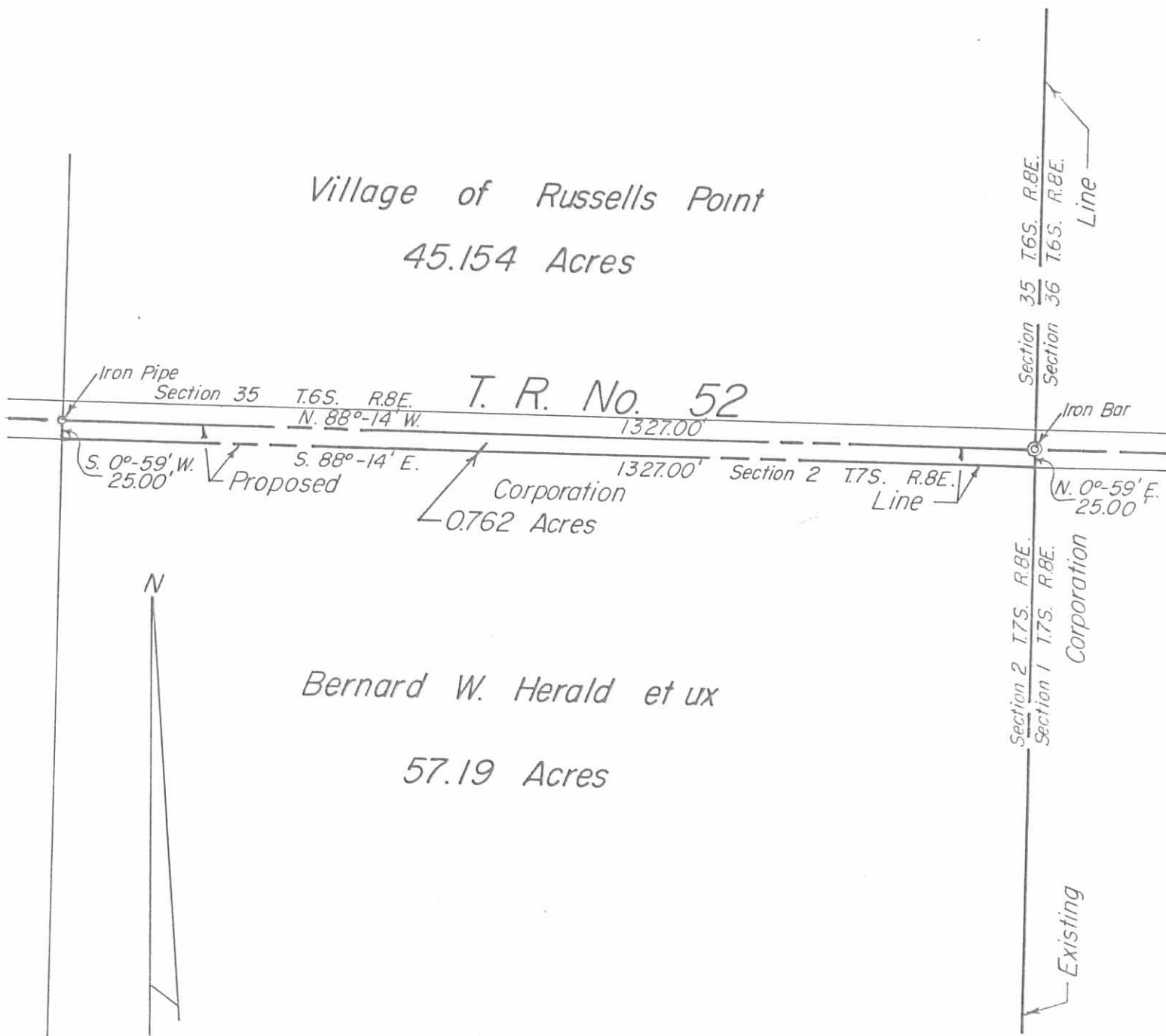
