Vol. 315 Page 130 and the northeast corner of John Timmermeister's 0.40 acre tract as described in D. B. Vol. 316 Page 856.

Thence with said Timmermeister's north line and the centerline of said private drive projected N. 30° 03' 20" W. 38.75 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set.

Thence N. 29° 55' 31" E. 170.80 feet to a point in the waters of Indian Lake, passing 5/8 inch iron bars set at 20.21 feet and 150.00 feet.

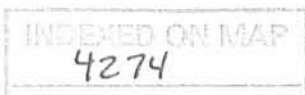
Thence S. 26° 18' 24" E. 55.99 feet to a point at the northwest corner of said Shirk's 0.32 acre tract.
