### SURVEY FOR KENNY GLENN 0.084 Acre Tract 1 November 11, 2003

The following described 0.084 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Stokes, V.M.S. 12276, being all of Kenneth P. Glenn, Jr. and Bonnie L. Pennington's Lot No. 504 and part of their Lot No. 503 of Chippewa Park No. 1 recorded in Plat Cabinet A, Slides 222 and 223, and described in Official Record 678, page 303, said 0.084 acre tract bring more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set at the southwest corner of Rulon F. and Belinda S. Spring's Lot No. 505, Tract I, described in Deed Volume 357, page 613, and at the northwest corner of said Lot No. 504, said pin being in the east right of way line of Big Bear Path (35 feet wide) and South 04°35'19" West 0.36 feet from a ½ inch iron pipe found, said pin marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence North 86°55'18" East 70.00 feet, following the south line of said Lot No. 505 and the north line of said Lot No. 504, to an iron pin set at the southwest corner of Rex N. and Judith R. Scheele's Lot No. 370 described in Official Record 177, page 963, and at the northwest corner of Shawn P. Hesser's Lot No. 371 described in Official Record 306, page 338;

Thence South 03°05'02" East 52.49 feet, following the east line of said Lot Nos. 504 and 503, the west line of said Lot No. 371 and the west line of Shawn P. Hesser's Lot No. 372 described in Official Record 306, page 338, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 86°55'18" West 70.00 feet, crossing said Lot No. 503, to an iron pin set in the east right of way line of Big Bear Path;

Thence North 03°04'42" West (assumed bearing) 52.49 feet, following the east right of way line of Big Bear Path and the west line of said Lot Nos. 503 and 504, to the place of beginning, containing 0.084 acre, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Thence North 03°04'42" West (assumed bearing) 52.50 feet, following the east right of way line of Big Bear Path and the west line of said Lots No. 502 and 503, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 86°55'18" East 70.00 feet, crossing said Lot No. 503, to an iron pin set in the west line of Shawn P. Hesser's Lot No. 372 described in Official Record 306, page 338;

Thence South 03°05'02" East 52.50 feet, following the east line of said Lot Nos. 503 and 502, the west line of said Lot No. 372 and the west line of Shawn P. Hesser's Lot No. 373 described in Official Record 306, page 338, to an iron pin set at the northwest corner of Rick L. and Melody A. 


