The diagram on the next page represents the location Addition to West Liberty Survey May 27. 1841 for Thomas P. Miller, Proprietor - Beginning at the S. E. corner of Lot N^o 1. planted a ^{lime} Stone marker & bearing S 22 1/2 E 52 links; from the South East corner of the Methodist Meeting house which occupies lot N^o 1. The observation taken from the corner of the basement story. N^o 1 & 5 front on Howell Street 75 feet extending back 150 feet. N^o 2 to 4 inclusive front on Reynolds Street 50 feet and extend back 150 feet. N^o 6 to 14 inclusive front on Reynolds Street 50 feet extending back 150 feet. - Reynolds Street is 70 feet wide - its present bearing is N 21.30 W agreeing with the present bearing of the old town. The extended street and alleys are on the same line of the street and alleys of the old town.
