## DESCRIPTION FOR 30.007 ACRE PARCEL

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Zane, being part of Virginia Military Survey 3154, and being a part of that 104.36 acre tract (Tract 1) as conveyed to Hugh B. Showe II Trustee et. al. by deed of record in Official Record Volume 199, Page 260, all references being to those of record in the Recorder's Office, Logan County, Ohio, said 30.007 acres being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing a 5/8" diameter rebar found in the centerline of County Highway 152 (50 foot wide) marking the southerly corner of said Showe tract, the same being the southeasterly line of said Virginia Military Survey 3154;

thence along said centerline, North 31°01'56" West, 905.71 feet to a PK nail set and being the Point of Beginning for the 30.007 acre parcel herein to be described;

thence continuing along said centerline, North 31°01'56" West, 917.84 feet to a PK nail set marking the westerly corner of said Showe tract;

thence leaving the centerline of County Highway 152 along the northwesterly line of said Showe tract and the southeasterly line of that 6.5 acre tract (First Tract) as conveyed to Margaret S. Chernek by deed of recorded in Official Record Volume 354, Page 947, North 54°40'00" East, 1393.70 feet to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin set at 30.08 feet and a 1" diameter steel pipe found at 1278.60 feet;

thence across said Showe tract the following two (2) courses and distances;

South 35°20'00" East, 915.25 feet to an iron pin set; and . . .

South 54°40'00" West, 1462.53 feet, passing an iron pin set at 1437.46 feet, to the **Point of Beginning** and containing 30.007 acres, (0.525 acres within existing right-of-way), more or less, according to a survey conducted by Jobes Henderson and Associates, Inc. in June of 2006.




All iron pins set are 5/8" in diameter rebar by 30" in length with red surveyors identification caps marked "J&H, PS 7900".







## THE NATURE CONSERVANCY SURVEY 17.543 ACRES July 5, 2011

The following described 17.543 acre tract of land is situated in Virginia Military Survey 3154, Zane Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Margaret S. Chernek's 6 ½ acre (First Tract), 7 acre (Second Tract), 10 acres, 2 rods and 27 poles (Third Tract) and 100 acre (Fourth Tract), all being described in Official Record Volume 354, page 947, said 17.543 acre tract more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a 5/8 inch iron bar found at the intersection of the centerline of County Road 152 (50 feet wide) (Log. Co. Eng. Field book 555, pages 19 thru 21) with the north line of Zane Township and the south line of Perry Township, said iron bar referenced as centerline Station 64+02 on page 21 of said field book 555, said iron bar also in the southwest line of said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract);

Thence South 17°08'42" East 337.12 feet, following the centerline of County Road 152 and the southwest line of said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract), to a magnetic nail found and marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence **North 89°45'43" East 328.78 feet**, departing from the centerline of County Road 152, entering said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract), passing an iron bar set at 31.36 feet, to an iron bar set;

Thence **North 85°29'17" East 158.14 feet**, leaving said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract) and entering said 10 acres, 2 rods, and 27 poles tract (Third Tract), to an iron bar set;

Thence South 83°26'58" East 124.38 feet to an iron bar set;

Thence South 50°03'42" East 254.70 feet to an iron bar set;

Thence South 45°55'23" East 180.52 feet to an iron bar set;

Thence North 69°33'41" East 553.25 feet, leaving said 10 acres, 2 rods, and 27 poles tract (Third Tract), crossing said 7 acre tract (Second Tract) and said 6 ½ acre tract (First Tract), to an iron bar set in the southwest line of The Nature Conservancy's 74.353 acre, Tract One, described in Official Record Volume 842, page 399;

Thence **South 41°15'39" East 207.00 feet**, following the southwest line of said 74.353 acre tract and the northeast line of said 6 ½ acre tract (First Tract), to a one inch iron pipe found in the northwest line of Collin B. Showe's (1/4 interest), Diandra N. Showe's (1/4 interest), Debra A. Showe's (1/4 interest), and Eric K. Showe's (1/4 interest) 30.007 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 936, pages 618, 621, 624 and 627, Official Record Volume 940, pages 718, 721, 724 and 727, and Official Record



Volume 1018, pages 687, 690, 693 and 696;

Thence South 55°13'42" West 1278.60 feet, following the northwest line of said 30.007 acre tract and the southeast line of said 6 ½ acre tract (First Tract), passing a 5/8 inch iron bar found at 1248.39 feet, to a magnetic nail found in the centerline of County Road 152:

Thence **North 30°22'24" West 459.57 feet**, following the centerline of County Road 152, the southwest lines of said 6 ½ acre tract (First Tract), said 7 acre tract (Second Tract), and said 10 acres, 2 rods, and 27 poles tract (Third Tract), to a magnetic nail found at centerline Station 54+00 as referenced on page 20 of said field book 555;

Thence **North 32°09'00"** West 468.37 feet, continuing along the centerline of County Road 152, following the southwest lines of said 10 acres, 2 rods, and 27 poles tract (Third Tract) and said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract), to a 5/8 inch iron bar found at centerline Station 58+68.5 as referenced on page 20 of said field book 555;

Thence North 17°08'42" West 196.77 feet, continuing along the centerline of County Road 152 and following the southwest line of said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract), to the place of beginning, containing 17.543 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above - described 17.543 acre tract of land, 6.694 acres are part of said  $6\frac{1}{2}$  acre tract (First Tract), 0.643 acre is part of said 7 acre tract (Second Tract), 9.450 acres are part of said 10 acres, 2 rods, and 27 poles tract (Third Tract), and 0.756 acre is part of said 100 acre tract (Fourth Tract).

The road right-of-way of County Road 152 contains 0.641 acre.

The above description was prepared from an actual field survey made by George A. Blackburn, Registered Surveyor #7873, during the month of July 2011. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch by 30 inch reinforcing rods with plastic caps marked "Blackburn RS #7873." Bearings indicated herein are based on the centerline of County Road 152 (50 feet wide) bearing North 32°09'00" West.


