The plat of survey (the "Survey") to which this certificate is attached, prepared by the undersigned, a professional registered engineer or registered land surveyor of Page Engineering, Inc., entitled "Plat of Boundary Survey -- Nippon Express U.S.A., Inc." was actually made by instrument survey

2. The Survey was prepared in accordance with the attached document entitled "Requirements For Survey" and contains and shows all information required

3. The Survey and the information courses and distances shown thereon, including, without limitation, all setback and yard lines, are correct; 4. The acreage contained in this property equals the amount shown on the

5. The boundary line dimensions of the property form a mathematically closed figure within  $\pm .01$  foot;

7. There are no buildings, structures or other improvements located within ten (10) feet of the perimeter boundary of this property, whether on or off site,

8. All utility services required for the operation of this property either enter this property through adjoining public rights of way or roads, or the Survey shows the point of entry and location of any easements and/or rights-of-way for any utilities which pass through or are located on adjoining private land;

9. This property has direct access to U.S. Route 33, a dedicated public way, along its northeasterly boundary for a distance of 1473 feet;

10. The Survey shows the location and direction of all storm drainage systems for the collection and disposal of all surface drainage, and any discharge into streams, rivers or other conveyance system is shown on the Survey;

11. This property does not lie within any flood hazard areas in accordance with the document entitled "Department of Housing and Urban Development, Federal Insurance Administration-Special Flood Hazard Area Maps", except for that portion of the property shown on the Survey as located within flood zone "A"; and




