

SURVEY FOR MICHELE NICHOLS EASEMENT May 25, 1999

The following described easement is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Jefferson, V.M.S. 3137, Village of Zanesfield, being over Michele L. Nichols' Lot 54 in Tennery Addition to said Village as recorded in plat cabinet A, slide 199 and described in Official Record Volume 97, page 84, said easement being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "Clapsaddle RS #6140" at the southeast corner of Lot 54 of said Addition and at the northeast corner of Margaret A. Johnson's Lot 55 of said Addition, said property further described in Official Record Volume 244, page 689, said iron pin also being in the west line of Main Street (60 feet wide) and marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence **North 72°01'15" West 163.09 feet**, departing from the west line of Main Street, following the north line of said Lot 55 and the south line of said Lot 54, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "Clapsaddle RS #6140" in the east line of a 16 feet wide alley;

Thence North 16°03'18" East 8.00 feet, following the east line of said 16 feet wide alley and the west line of said Lot 54, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 72°01'15" East 163.08 feet, departing from the east line of said 16 feet wide alley and crossing said Lot 54, to an iron pin set in the west line of Main Street;

Thence South 16°00'00" West 8.00 feet, following the west line of Main Street and the east line of said Lot 54, to the place of beginning, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

The above description was prepared from an actual field survey made under the supervision of Paul R. Clapsaddle, Registered Surveyor #6140 during the month of May 1999. Iron pins set are 5/8" by 30" reinforcing rods with caps marked "CLAPSADDLE RS #6140." Bearings indicated herein are based on the centerline of Main Street being South 16°00'00" West, with all others based on angles turned.

ORDINANCE NO. 91-02




AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY IN THE VILLAGE OF ZANESFIELD, OHIO, LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF MAIN STREET AND BOUNDED BY LANDS OWNED BY KENNETH A. AND TAMARA S. KLINE, fka KELLER, AND MICHELE LOUISE NICHOLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Zanesfield, Logan County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto having voted in favor of suspending the three reading rule:

That the alley in the Village of SECTION 1: Zanesfield and described as follows: Situated in the Village of Zanesfield, Jefferson Township, Virginia Military Survey 3137, Logan County, Ohio and being a 16 foot alley 160 feet in length located on the west side of Main Street and bounded on the north by a tract of land owned by Tamara S. Keller(w153) and on the south by a tract of land (LOT 54) owned by Michelle Louise Nichols, Ashall be hereafter vacated and closed to the traffic of any and all vehicles, Being part of Tennery's Addition (Plat Cabinet A, Slide 200)

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Zanesfield, Ohio. The reason for such



necessity is that the alley vacation authorized by this Ordinance will help to clear up title problems that have arisen between the Village and landowners whose properties adjoin the alley and the vacation will further relieve the Village from any and all liabilities and duties of maintenance associated with the alley. Therefore, the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
