

SURVEY FOR THE VILLAGE OF ZANESFIELD

0.305 Acres

The following described 0.305 acre tract of land is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Jefferson, V.M.S. 3137, being all of the Village of Zanesfield's "south 35 feet of Lot 9, except south 5 feet of Lot 9", described in Deed Volume 352, page 725, part of the "north 40 feet of Lot 10" and all of the "south 4 feet of Lot 9" described in Deed Volume 73, page 585 (prior deeds referred to this as "south 5 feet of Lot 9" and used for this survey), and all of the "east 48 feet of the south 30 feet of Lot 10" described in Deed Volume 62, page 178, all Lots referenced on the original plat for the Village of Zanesfield as filed in Plat Cabinet A, Slide 199, said 0.305 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point marking the southeast corner of said Lot 10, said point being at the intersection of the north line of Sugar Alley (16 feet wide) with the west line of Cherry Alley (16 feet wide), said point marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence **South 85°04'17" West (assumed bearing) 48.00 feet**, following the south line of said "east 48 feet of the south 30 feet of Lot 10" and the north line of Sugar Alley, passing at 0.13 feet a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch iron pipe found, to an iron pin set at the southeast corner of Jane Ellen Faber's tract described in Official Record 252, page 593 (no area indicated);

Thence **North 5°38'29" West 30.00 feet**, following the east line of said Faber's tract and the west line of said "east 48 feet of the south 30 feet of Lot 10", to an iron pin set at the northeast corner of said Faber's tract and in the south line of said "north 40 feet of Lot 10";

Thence **South 85°04'17" West 9.78 feet**, following the north line of said Faber's tract and the south line of said "north 40 feet of Lot 10", to an iron pin set;

Thence **North 4°55'43" West 4.00 feet**, departing from the north line of said Faber's and entering said "north 40 of Lot 10", to an iron pin set;

Thence **South 85°04'17" West 6.00 feet** to an iron pin set;


Thence **South 4°55'43" East 2.00 feet** to an iron pin set;

Thence **South 85°04'17" West 54.00 feet** to an iron pin set;

Thence **South 4°55'43" East 2.00 feet** to an iron pin set in the north line of said Faber's tract and in the south line of said "north 40 feet of Lot 10";

Thence **South 85°04'17" West 42.23 feet**, following the north line said Faber's tract and the south line of said "north 40 feet of Lot 10", to a magnetic nail set in a concrete sidewalk, said magnetic nail being in the east line of Sandusky Street (60 feet wide) and in the west line said Lot 10;

Thence **North 5°38'29" West 75.00 feet**, following the east line of Sandusky Street and





Thence **North 85°04'17" East 160.00 feet**, following the south line of said "35 feet on the north side of Lot 9" and the north line of said "south 35 feet of Lot 9, except south 5 feet of Lot 9", passing at 2.96 feet a 5/8 inch iron pin found, to an iron pin set in the west line of Cherry Alley and in the east line of Lot 9;



THENCE, with the said north line of the Faber portion of Lot 10, S 85°-07'-23"W, a distance of 54.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning for reference at a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch iron pin found at the southeast corner of Lot 10, at the northeast corner of Sugar Alley (16'), and in the west line of Cherry Alley (16');




