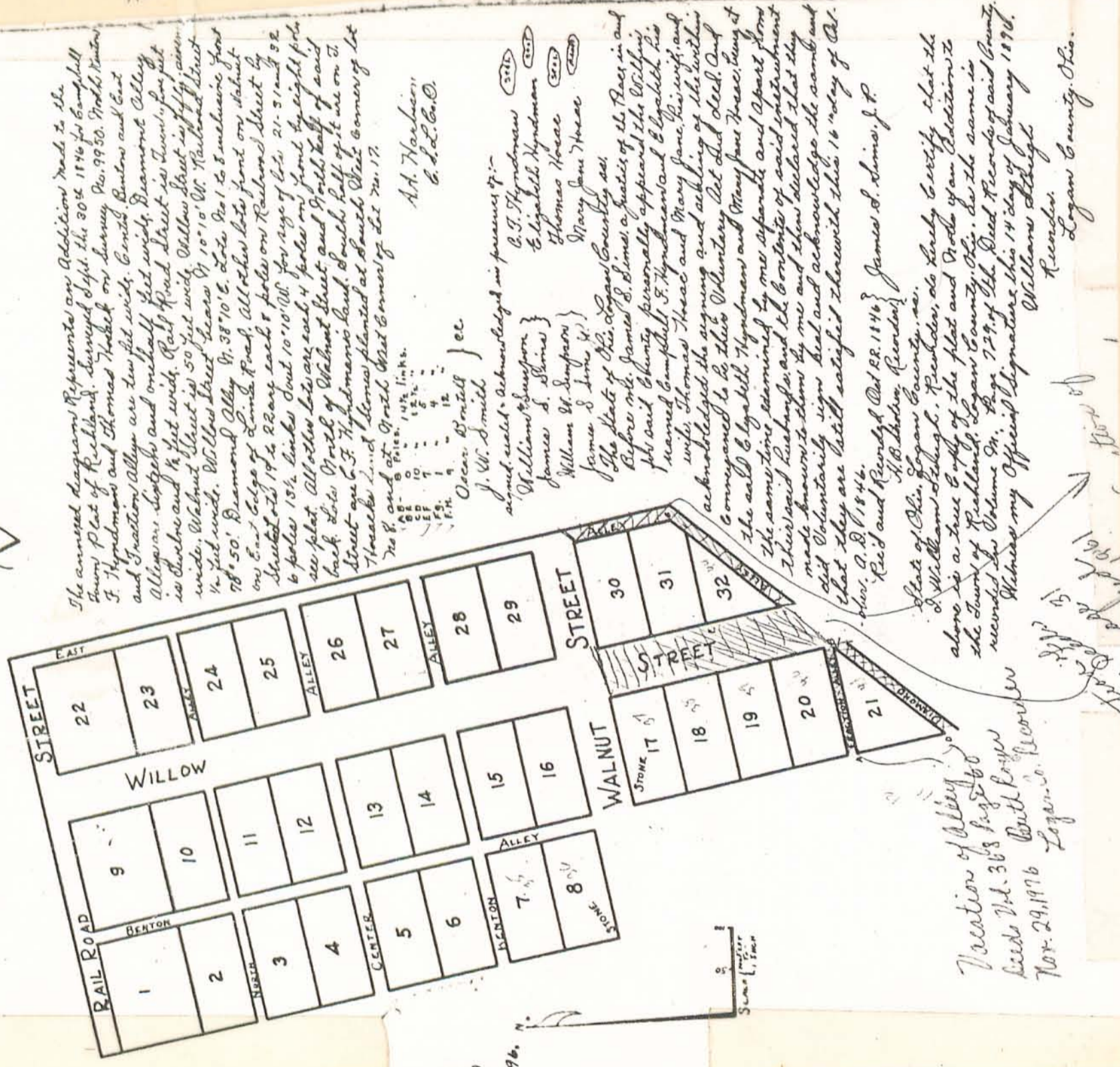

NOTES

"A" LOGAN COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT, RECORD BOOK "T" Pg. 56
 Shows that a vacation on lots in this area was ordered by the findings of this court action. Vacated was Lots 9 Thru 16 and Lots 22-29; Willow Street, North of Walnut Street; Railroad St adjacent to the above lots; all alleys adjacent to above lots except Benton Alley of Richland Addition, Plat Cabinet "A" Slide 155.

RICHLAND ADDITION



The annexed diagrams, Reports and Additions made to the Survey Plat of Richland, surveyed Sept. 11, 1894, for Grand Hill by F. Hyattman and Thomas Hackett on Survey No. 9950, North Street and Benton Alley are two feet wide, Benton Alley and East Willow, Streets and alleys, East Street, Diamond Alley, Benton Alley and Railroad Street are two feet wide, Willow Street is 16 feet wide, Walnut Street is 50 feet wide, Railroad Street is 16 feet wide, Benton Alley is 33' 10" wide, No. 1 to 8 inclusive front on E. side of Willow Street, all other lots front on Walnut Street 14 to 22 are each 4 poles on Railroad Street by 6 poles, 13 to 16 are each 4 poles on front by eight poles back, all other lots are each 4 poles on front by eight poles back, No. 9 of Walnut Street and North half of said Street are F. Hyattman's land, South half of it is on W. Hackett's land, Thomas Hackett at South East corner of Lot No. 8, and at North West corner of Lot No. 17.
